

YEAR IN REVIEW 2023

A Garden In Every Lot, a program of UNI's Center for Energy and Environmental Education, aims to renew our community's culture of backyard gardening. We help individuals and community organizations overcome barriers to starting a garden. We offer garden site assessment & preparation, tilling, seeds, and plant starts, and more!



141 GARDENS INSTALLED

With 43 gardens installed in 2023, A Garden in Every Lot has reached **141** gardeners, spanning 8 cities in Black Hawk County, including Cedar Falls, Denver, Evansdale, Hudson, Jessup, La Porte City, Waterloo, and Waverly!

WATERLOO TOOL LIBRARY

As of 2022, gardening equipment has been available for check-out at the Tool Library at the Waterloo Public Library. Since then, a collection of 64 gardening tools circulated a total of 188 times!

SURVEY RESULTS

In December of 2023, a survey was sent to past gardeners. Of those who filled it out, 89% of first time gardeners felt more confident in growing their own veggies, and plan to continue gardening!
